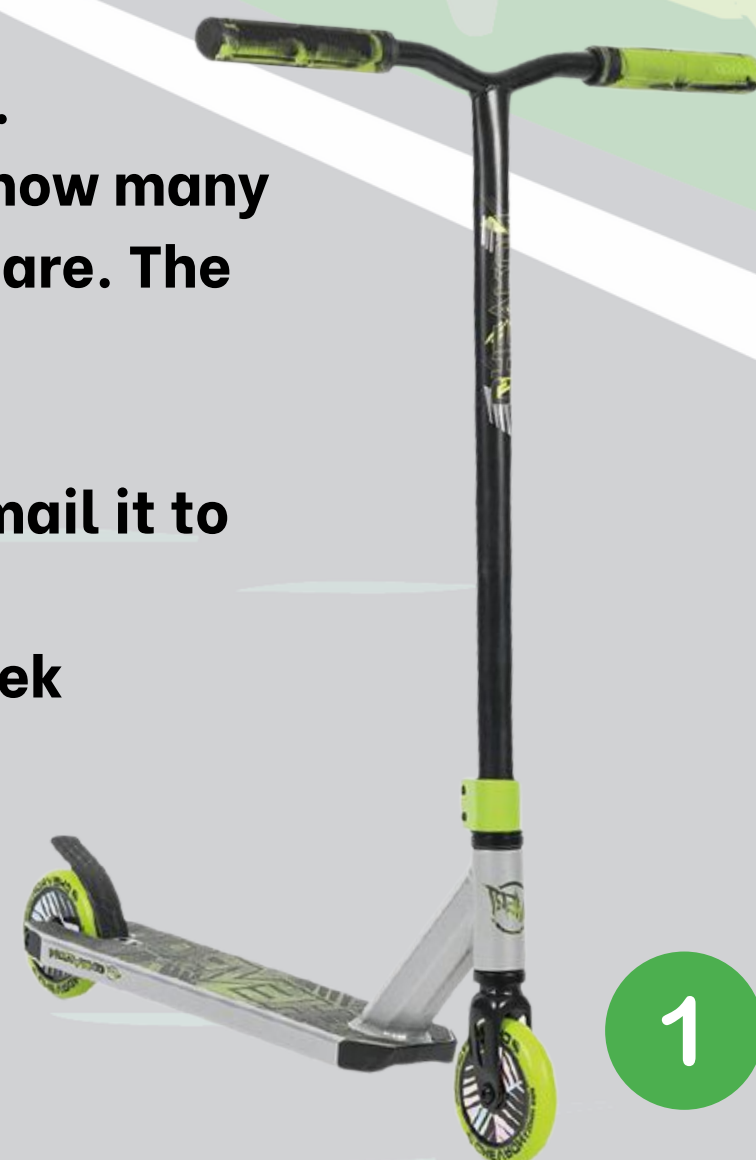

Car Safety Check

Safety first! Make sure you complete this check with the car parked in a safe location, completely off the road. Never carry out the check while driving or stopped in a dangerous location.

1. The “Blink & Flash” Light Test

- Kid’s Job: Stand at a safe distance in front of (and then behind) the car while a parent sits inside.
- What to Check: Give a thumbs-up or thumbs-down as the driver tests:
 - ☐ Headlights and high beams
 - ☐ Left and right indicator blinks
 - ☐ Brake lights (when parent presses the pedal)
 - ☐ Reverse lights

2. Tyre Pressure & Tread Check

- Kid’s Job: Help press the tyre pressure gauge onto the valve stem or do the “20-cent coin test.”
- What to Check:
 - ☐ Check the air pressure numbers on all four tyres against the recommended number (usually on the sticker inside the driver’s door frame).
 - ☐ Check tread depth: Place a coin into the grooves of the tyre. If you can see the whole outer rim of the coin, the tread might be too worn.
 - ☐ Look and feel around the sides for any visible nails, deep cracks, or bulges.

3. The “Blue Juice” Wiper Fluid Top-Up

- Kid’s Job: Help locate the cap under the bonnet with the windscreen wiper symbol on it.
- What to Check:
 - ☐ Pop the bonnet open (with a parent handling the hot parts).
 - ☐ Uncap the fluid reservoir and check if the blue/green fluid level is near the top.
 - ☐ Pour in windshield washer fluid using a funnel until full.

4. Seatbelt “Click & Tug” Test

- Kid’s Job: Test every seatbelt in the car, even the empty ones.
- What to Check:
 - ☐ Pull each belt out, buckle it into the latch, and listen for a solid “click.”
 - ☐ Give it a sharp, firm tug to make sure it locks into place properly.
 - ☐ If using booster or car seats, push down firmly on them to ensure they don’t slide more than an inch side-to-side.

5. Crystal Clear Mirror & Window Clean

- Kid’s Job: Clean the glass so the driver has zero blind spots.
- What to Check:
 - ☐ Spray glass cleaner on the side mirrors, rear-view mirror, and front/back windows.
 - ☐ Wipe off all bugs, smudges, and dirt with a cloth.

6. Dashboard Ready Check

- Kid’s Job: Sit in the passenger seat and look at the dashboard when the car turns on.
- What to Check:
 - ☐ Check the fuel gauge (or battery level if electric) to make sure it’s at 100%.
 - ☐ Check for any warning lights staying on (like check engine, ABS, or low pressure lights).
