What is the Fund about?

What is funded?

- Rangatahi Empowerment & Pathways
- (Environmental Initiatives will be referred to WWF NZ)

\$500-\$5,000 annually for up to 3 years

What is not funded?

Funding may not be used for:

- Projects that are part of core governmental funding (ie Govt already fund them)
- health
- disability
- core education
- sport & recreation
- drama / art / performing arts

How to apply?

Contact the Local Donation administrator Kerri at Tararua REAP for an application form. Complete it fully and return before deadline 20 October.

Allocation is early November, and Reports are due July the following year.
