# What is Skinny Jump??

Subsidised broadband for Kiwi homes. Skinny Jump is for those who do not have a broadband connection at home because cost is a barrier. It is \$5 per 30 GB and you can top up 5 x per month. (so total of \$25 for 125 GB). That is a pretty good deal!

This plan is specifically designed to support those most at risk of digital exclusion, as identified in the government's digital inclusion blueprint. Is **Skinny Jump for you?** Those eligible include families with children, job seekers, seniors, people with disabilities, refugees, and migrant communities, or those living in social housing:
